

RMAX[®] BELOW GRADE SLAB ON GRADE APPLICATION

Rmax[®] Below Grade may be installed horizontally under foundations and vertically inside of the footings. A separate vapor retarder sheet should be installed over or under the insulation against the crushed stone base and well tamped backfill or undisturbed earth. Simply lay in the insulation with tightly butted joints.

Refer to Rmax[®] Below Grade Product Data Sheet for additional application/installation, compliances, thermal and physical properties, limitations and warnings.



NOTE:

- 1. Use of the insulation board in areas where the probability of termite infestation is "very heavy" must be in accordance with Chapter 26 of the IBC.
- 2. Exact placement of the polyethylene vapor barrier is up to the building designer and local code requirements.
