

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Shelter Dynamics has collaborated with several manufacturers focused on energy savings on a sustainable home intended to showcase new concepts for efficient building and sustainability. The Arc House totals 423 square feet (versus 2,657 square feet, the average size of new homes built today). The unique design uses arches to make a small space "feel" expansive, exhibiting a focus on functionality with great value. Designed to flow like a wave, the Arc House represents a new dwelling concept, combining the economy and simplicity of tiny house living with cutting edge building science.

The Arc House is designed to achieve net-zero energy usage with a hybrid insulation system of Thermasheath® polyiso board from Rmax, along with Covestro's Bayseal CCX SPF, which combines to form a thermal value of R-40.
